



Background

 Recreation area created on the West side by the Flood Control System






River Corridor Redevelopment Plan (2008-2009)



Background

- Cedar Rapids Greenway Parks Plan (2014)
 - Over 300 participants from the general public
 - Outreach with a variety of user groups
- Over 100 acres of park/recreation area





Why - Greenway Plan Update

- Updated West side Flood Control System alignment
- Established feasibility of whitewater park
- 1st and 1st West Project



Purpose - Greenway Plan Update

- Engagement with the community to build momentum
- Collaboration to enhance amenities through other City projects
- Positions City to be competitive for federal funding




Greenway Plan Update

- Joint project led by Parks and Recreation and Community Development
- City awarded contract to Michael Van Valkenburgh Associates Inc. (MVVA)
 - With subcontractors:
 - Anderson Bogert (local civil engineering)
 - Seelman Landscape Architecture (local landscape architect)
 - Limnotech (environmental and water resources engineering)
 - Landwise (economic advisor)




Community Engagement Draft Concepts

- Online Survey
 - Interactive review of concepts and opportunity to provide feedback
 - 451 responses





 82% of respondents say the Greenway Park concepts address/align with many or all of the community's needs

 - 5. Open Space (Picnic Grove, Valley Lawn, Levee Overlook, etc.)


Which three park amenities would you like to see most?
